# **JJECI Guide to Graphical Abstracts & Highlights**

This guide provides detailed instructions for authors preparing optional **Graphical Abstracts** and **Highlights** for their manuscripts submitted to the *Jordanian Journal of Engineering and Chemical Industries (JJECI)*.

# **Graphical Abstract**

A **graphical abstract** is a concise, visual summary of the main findings of your study. It improves discoverability, especially on digital platforms.

# **Purpose**

- Captures the essence of your paper in one image
- · Increases article visibility and reader engagement

### Requirements

- File Format: PNG, JPEG, TIFF, PDF, or PPT
- Size: Minimum 5 cm (height) x 13 cm (width)
- Resolution: At least 96 dpi (higher recommended for clarity)
- Color: Allowed; no charge
- **Text**: Keep minimal and legible (avoid small font sizes)
- Font: Use clear, readable fonts (e.g., Arial, Calibri)
- No axes labels or figure numbers required

### **Content Tips**

- Use diagrams, process flows, reaction schemes, or conceptual illustrations
- Avoid crowded visuals or excessive detail
- · Clearly highlight the novelty or outcome of the research

### **Submission**

- Embed in manuscript or attach as a separate file
- Label as: Graphical Abstract [AuthorName].png

# **Highlights**

Highlights are a set of bullet points summarizing the key aspects of your paper. They are optional but highly recommended.

#### **Format**

Number: 3 to 5 bullet points

• Length: Max 85 characters per point

• Language: Clear, concise, and informative

• Style: Use sentence fragments without ending punctuation

## **Example Highlights**

- Efficient catalyst synthesized using green chemistry
- Enhanced hydrogen yield observed at lower temperatures
- Model validated against industrial case study data
- Eco-friendly approach reduces waste by 45%
- Scalable method suitable for large-scale application

### **Submission**

- Place after the author list in the manuscript (before the abstract), or submit as a separate page
- Title the section as: Highlights

### **Notes**

- Both the graphical abstract and highlights are **not mandatory**, but encouraged for improved online visibility.
- Submissions without these elements are still eligible for review and publication.
