## **JJECI Publication Ethics and Consent Policy**

The Jordanian Journal of Engineering and Chemical Industries (JJECI) adheres to the highest ethical standards and follows the principles outlined by the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) and other global best practice bodies such as DOAJ, OASPA, and WAME. JJECI is published by the Deanship of Research, Al-Balqa Applied University, and is issued by the Scientific Research Fund, Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, Jordan.

## **Research Integrity and Misconduct**

- Misconduct is defined as any action (intentional or unintentional) that may mislead others into believing false or manipulated research outcomes.
- Examples: plagiarism, data fabrication or falsification, duplicate submission, and unethical experimentation.
- In cases of serious misconduct, JJECI may notify the author's institution or funder and retract published articles.

## **Authorship and Contributions**

- All listed authors must have made significant intellectual contributions.
- The corresponding author is responsible for ensuring all co-authors approve the final version.
- CRediT taxonomy should be used to define each author's role.

## **Originality and Plagiarism**

- Manuscripts must be original, unpublished, and not under consideration elsewhere.
- JJECI uses similarity detection tools to identify plagiarism.
- Proper attribution of sources is mandatory; failure to do so may result in immediate rejection or retraction.

## **Ethical Approvals and Consent**

- Research involving human participants or animals requires ethical clearance.
- Authors must:
  - Obtain and declare ethics approval from a recognized institutional review board
  - Secure written informed consent for any human subject data or images
  - Submit consent statements upon request

### **Conflicts of Interest**

- Authors must disclose any financial or non-financial conflicts that could influence the results.
- Example: personal relationships, funding sources, or affiliations that may bias the work.
- Standard declaration: "The authors declare no conflict of interest."

### Confidentiality

- Editors, reviewers, and staff must maintain strict confidentiality of submitted manuscripts.
- Unpublished data or ideas must not be used for personal advantage.

#### **Peer Review Ethics**

- JJECI employs a double-blind peer review process.
- Authors must respect confidentiality and revise manuscripts according to reviewer feedback.
- Any manipulation of peer review (e.g., fake reviewer identities) is considered misconduct.

## **Author Declarations Upon Acceptance**

To ensure ethical compliance and enable proper indexing, authors must submit the following signed documents upon manuscript acceptance:

- Plagiarism and Artificial Intelligence Declaration Form
- Copyright Transfer Agreement

These forms affirm author accountability and transfer the necessary rights for open-access distribution under the Creative Commons license.

## **Open Access and Licensing**

- JJECI is a fully open-access journal.
- All articles are published under the Creative Commons CC BY 4.0 license, permitting unrestricted use with proper attribution.
- No article processing charges (APCs) or color figure fees are applied.

## Archiving, Indexing, and Journal Management

- JJECI ensures permanent self-archiving via its website and complies with standard copyright and licensing frameworks.
- Digital Object Identifiers (DOIs) are assigned via Crossref.
