

JJECl Publication Ethics and Consent Policy

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- Misconduct is defined as any action (intentional or unintentional) that may mislead others into believing false or manipulated research outcomes.
- Examples: plagiarism, data fabrication or falsification, duplicate submission, and unethical experimentation.
- In cases of serious misconduct, JJECl may notify the author's institution or funder and retract published articles.

Authorship and Contributions

- All listed authors must have made significant intellectual contributions.
- The corresponding author is responsible for ensuring all co-authors approve the final version.
- CRediT taxonomy should be used to define each author's role.

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- Manuscripts must be original, unpublished, and not under consideration elsewhere.
- JJECl uses similarity detection tools to identify plagiarism.
- Proper attribution of sources is mandatory; failure to do so may result in immediate rejection or retraction.

Ethical Approvals and Consent

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 - Obtain and declare ethics approval from a recognized institutional review board
 - Secure written informed consent for any human subject data or images
 - Submit consent statements upon request

Conflicts of Interest

- Authors must disclose any financial or non-financial conflicts that could influence the results.
- Example: personal relationships, funding sources, or affiliations that may bias the work.
- Standard declaration: *"The authors declare no conflict of interest."*

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- Unpublished data or ideas must not be used for personal advantage.

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- Authors must respect confidentiality and revise manuscripts according to reviewer feedback.
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To ensure ethical compliance and enable proper indexing, authors must submit the following signed documents upon manuscript acceptance:

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- **Copyright Transfer Agreement**

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- Digital Object Identifiers (DOIs) are assigned via Crossref.
